

Things to do at home:

Ideas for home-made books

- A faces book - of people who are important to your child.
- A peek-a-boo lift-the-flap book - with flaps over images of people, pets or places that are special to your child.



- A feely book - made from materials with different textures e.g. foil, denim, sand paper, corrugated card etc.



- An animal sounds book - with pictures of animals that make sounds, e.g. cat, dog, duck, sheep, cow, pig etc.
- A favourite toys book - with images from catalogues.
- A favourite foods book - using cut out pictures and words from food packets or magazines.
- A 'Things I have found' book - with envelopes on each page for the child to put their 'findings' in, such as leaves, twigs, pictures etc.
- Information books - about things that fascinate your child, e.g. dinosaurs, pirates, pets, diggers etc.
- A 'My day out' book - about a trip that your child has enjoyed, maybe to the shops, the park, the beach or a holiday. Stick envelopes on the pages to hold things they have collected, e.g. bus tickets, leaves, postcards etc.



They don't just have to be paper or card – you could make an electronic book on a computer or try using an app on a phone.
