

Making Incy Wincy Spider

You will need: wool of different colours (or string), paper, scissors, glue and a kitchen roll tube.

Making spiders helps children to:

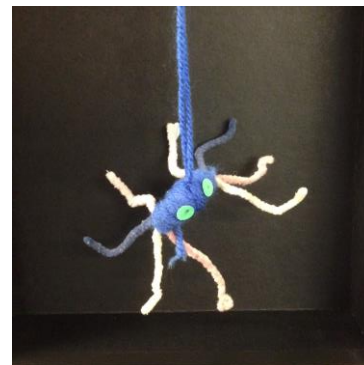
- ☀️ practise counting
- ☀️ talk about colours
- ☀️ talk about *big* and *little*, *long* and *short*
- ☀️ practise using scissors.

What to do:

1. Spiders are easy to make so let your child lead the way!
 - Cut four pieces of wool, all the same length, for the legs.
 - Tie them together in the middle by wrapping another piece of wool round and round to make the spider's body.
 - Cut out two small circles of paper for eyes and stick them onto the body.
2. Enjoy singing and acting out the rhyme together, using the kitchen roll tube as a spout.
3. You could make lots of different sized and coloured spiders and make up stories about them.
