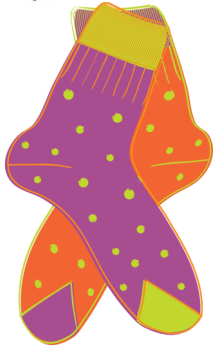




## Early Maths | Maths in everyday routines - Socks!
