I spy numbers

You will need: just you and your child (and paper and pencil if you want to draw later)

Playing I spy numbers helps children to:

- 55 notice that numbers are all around them
- think about why we use numbers
- begin to recognise numbers.

What to do:

- 1. Look out for numbers around the house or in the street while you are doing things together.
- 2. Ask your child if they can find any numbers for example on a clock or a washing machine, or on a front door or a bus. This is a game, not a test if they're not sure, just point numbers out to them and they'll gradually start to recognise them.
- 3. Your child might like to draw a picture of some of the things that you've seen during the day you could encourage them to include some of the numbers. Don't worry if their numbers don't look like 'real' numbers that will come with practice, and takes a while!
