## Non-Compliance

If a student arrives at school without the proper uniform, school staff will inquire about the reason for the discrepancy and document the incident. If this happens, the staff will communicate with the student's parent or caregiver via letter to provide a gentle reminder. School has spare uniform should this be required & a supply of nearly new uniform to purchase

If the student continues to arrive without the correct uniform, the staff will contact the parent or caregiver by phone to discuss the issue and may request that they bring the uniform to school. If the student repeatedly fails to comply with uniform rules, the parent or caregiver will be asked to attend a meeting with senior school leaders and members of the governing body to address the issue.

## Jewellery.

Pupils are not permitted to wear jewellery due to health & safety risks with the exception of a watch (needs to be taken off for PE)

## Shoes

Fully black shoes or trainers should be worn. Pupils are not permitted to wear boots.

Block heels of no more than 3cm may be worn

## Labels

**ALL Clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with the pupil's name**
