School Lunches Price Increase

Unfortunately, and with deepest regret, we are writing to inform you of a price review for school meals provided to children within school.

This price review has arisen due to a number of inflationary pressures affecting our foodservice providers; Orian. These include:

*Food cost inflation has risen by a massive 29% over the past 2 years and remains high at 9.2%

*General rates of inflation have remained stubbornly high over the past year impacting on other production, distribution and transport costs.

Unfortunately this has forced us to have to increase our meal price to the children as a result of these cost pressures on our foodservice providers.

The cost of a child's lunch will increase from £2.95 to £3.10 per day; this is for Nursery children and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will continue to receive Universal Free School meals, as will those pupils in receipt of Free School Meals. This is due to take effect from Tuesday 16th April 2024, following our return from our Easter break. Lunchshop will be updated for our return.

This is due to take effect from **Monday 1st April 2024.**




