A letter was sent out on last week regarding our Annual Sports Day, which is due to take place on **Friday 22nd May 2026**.

It will take place at the Copeland Athletics Stadium and is for all children from **Reception to Year 6**. Nursery will be having a separate sports day on an alternative date.

The children will be transported from school by bus between 9 and 9.30a.m. They will take part in a carousel of activities throughout the morning.

Children who usually have school lunches will be provided with a school packed lunch which has been organised within school. Those children who bring their own packed lunch will need to do so as normal for this day.

ALL children will need a refillable water bottle and school will provide additional snacks for the day.

Parents/carers are invited to spectate and can arrive from 12 noon, with races beginning at 12.30p.m.

Our wonderful CPTA will be on site selling refreshments, snacks and sweets (cash only).

Children will need to come into school on this day wearing a T-shirt in the colour of their allocated team (red/white/blue) with P.E bottoms (shorts/joggers/leggings) and appropriate footwear-NO converse
