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Move Up Day/Welcome To Meetings

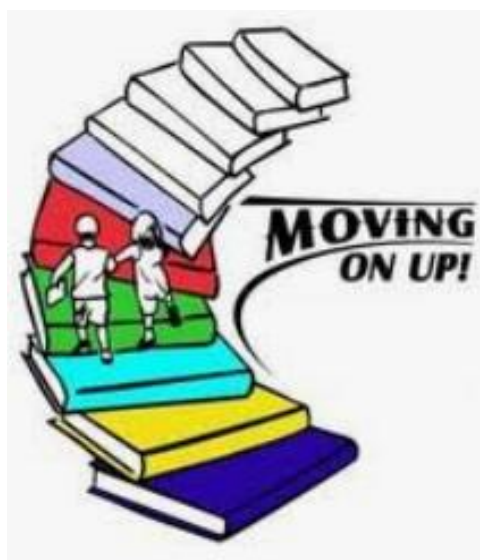
Thank you to all the parents and carers who attended our 'Welcome to' meetings on Wednesday.
